1. <i>What do traditional learners need to return to school?</i>	Traditional learners need the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Negative COVID-19 test ● Masks ● Bible ● Bookbag ● Personal water bottle ● Appropriate school uniform ● Lunch/Lunchbag No other school supplies!
2. <i>What do virtual learners need to return to school?</i>	Virtual learners need the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Bible ● Appropriate school uniform Please come to pick up school supplies, textbooks and devices on Thursday, 8/5/2021. Also, please make sure virtual learners eat meals before class begins.
3. <i>Are students required to get the COVID vaccination?</i>	For those of age, students are encouraged to be vaccinated, but not required. If your child is vaccinated, please submit a copy of his/her vaccination card to the office.
4. <i>Who is teaching what?</i>	Stevenson: Kindergarten - 2 nd (multi-grade) T. Doerner: 3 rd - 4 th (multi-grade) N. Hampton: 5 th - 8 th English Language Arts A. Williams: 5 th - 12 th Science S. <p>5. <i>What supplies does my child need?</i></p>	<p>School supplies, such as pencils, notebooks, paper, glue, will be provided for the students. For traditional learners, it is optional to bring pocket size/travel size tissue, hand sanitizer and wipes. However, these items will be available in every classroom.</p>
<p>6. <i>What will arrival look like?</i></p>	<p>Arrival Procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pull into the left side of the driveway and drive around the parking lot to the front of the building. ● Please have your child remain in the vehicle until a staff member checks his/her temperature. ● Once screening is completed, the student can enter. ● Parents are asked to limit building visits.
<p>7. <i>What will dismissal look like?</i></p>	<p>Dismissal Procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pull into the left side of the driveway and drive around the parking lot. ● Parents may wait for our 3:00pm dismissal in their vehicles, but do not line up until the bus pulls up to the front of the building. ● Car tags (issued first day of school) must be hanging from the rearview mirror.
<p>8. <i>What do students wear?</i></p>	<p>All students are to be in uniform, whether they are traditional or virtual learners. Students must wear oxford and/or polo shirts--colors of white, light blue or yellow; 9th - 12th wear navy, yellow, black, grey, white or light blue colors.</p> <p>For bottoms, males must wear navy pants in grades K5-8th; for grades 9th-12th must wear navy, black or khaki pants. For females in grades K5-8th must wear plaid jumper or skirt, navy jumper or skirt; for grades 9th-12th must wear navy, black or khaki pants or skirts. Please note, K5-8th grade females can only wear pants from October - March.</p>

<p>9. <i>What type of book bag can students have?</i></p>	<p>Students can have a sturdy book bag to carry their school items. The bags do not have to be clear. The only restriction is they cannot have images/prints that conflict with our Christian values and beliefs.</p>
<p>10. <i>Will lunch be provided for students?</i></p>	<p>Hot meals will not be served in the cafeteria. Breakfast and Lunch meals will be provided for pickup when parents complete the weekly meal orders for each student. Breakfast: students can eat at home before arrival or eat at school before 7:45am. Lunch: students will bring their ordered meals in their lunch bags to school. IF parents opt out of ordering weekly meals, food items brought into the school building must follow the guidelines (no pork, no shellfish--see Handbook for details).</p>
<p>11. <i>As a parent, can I still visit the school?</i></p>	<p>While we love having you involved in the learning environment, please limit to absolutely necessary visits.</p>
