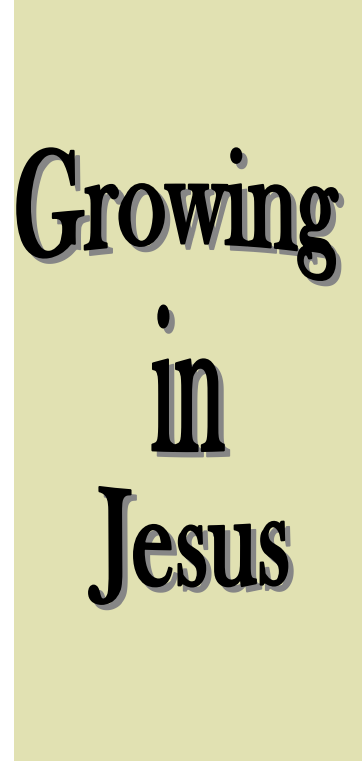
sus by helping others as Jesus commands us.
