They break down the Financial side of things so they are easy to find and understand. They will help fill out the Financial Agreement form. These Work Sheets are for you to keep in your folder.

CCS tuition is figured on 2 factors:

1. The Responsible Party's (Parents or Guardians) membership at the Concord SDA Church. A Constituent is a member of the Concord SDA Church. A Non-Constituent is a member of another Adventist Church. A Non-Adventist is not a member of the SDA church at large.
2. The second factor is how many students the Responsible Party is enrolling. This helps determine the discounts off the tuition for second and third students.

CCS tuition rates below are color coded for quick reference. Locate the section that applies to your membership status at the Concord SDA Church. Next, select the tuition rate that matches the number of students you are enrolling. Note that the discounts are explained and calculated for you. The selections are coded ie: C-I, or NC-II, etc. This is for quick note taking and for those needing to use the Pro-ration Rates on the next page.

Registration Fee: \$300.00 due at time of Registration, each student, all grades, non-refundable.

If you are members of non-constituent SDA church, you may wish to check with your church office to see if any special subsidy is available to offset the tuition difference. Additionally you may wish to suggest that your church consider joining the constituency.
