Please label the following items with student's name:

- 2 bottles of white glue
- 12 glue sticks
- 1 box of 24 crayons and/or colored pencils
- 4 big pink erasers
- 1 ruler with centimeters and inches
- 1 package of 3" x 3" sticky notes
- 2 boxes of washable classic colors broad markers 
- Optional: other marker colors (bright, neon, assorted, etc.)
- 1 package of multicolored highlighters
- 1 clipboard
- 2 small marker boxes
- 2 pairs of scissors
- 2 wide-ruled composition notebooks (any color) 
- 1 watercolor paints
- Youth Waders (Academy Sports or Amazon about \$28-\$65) 
- Rain boots (if not attached to waders) The taller the better.
- Rain coat
- Headphones or earbuds
- 1" 3-ring binder
- Zipper pouch for 3-ring binder
- 5 insertable plastic/vinyl pocket dividers for 3-ring binder (asst. colors) 
- 1 red 2-pocket plastic folder
- 1 pocket folder of your choice (school appropriate designs)
- Lunch box
- Spill-proof water bottle
- Folding camping chair
- 2 backpacks: 1 regular backpack, 1 clear for Forest School (Eastport under \$15)
- Old oversized shirt (for craft smock)
- Extra change of clothing (including socks and underwear) 

General Items that don't have to be labeled:

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 packages of wide ruled loose leaf paper
- 20-30 #2 pencils-plain yellow & good quality (i.e. Ticonderoga, etc.) or mechanical pencils
- 2 reams of white copy paper (400-500 sheets each)
