Hello Eagle Church family,

You answered the call!

In the last newsletter I wrote about the Parable of the Good Samaritan. As you may recall, at the end of the parable the lawyer answered Jesus, saying that the neighborly person was the one who showed mercy to the beaten man. Jesus then commanded the lawyer, as well as each one of us, His followers, to “Go and do likewise.”

On the second Sabbath of August we had 31 members and visitors of the Eagle church follow Jesus’ command to “Go”. It was 102° and unhealthy air quality that day, but you showed up in a big way! After potluck we had 12 people walk the neighboring streets of the church praying for each household, 12 people knocked on our neighbors’ doors offering prayer and inviting them to the upcoming “Islam & Christianity” seminar in September, 4 people stayed in the sanctuary and prayed for the walkers and the neighbors, and 3 people drove the streets of Eagle praying for each home. After one hour we came back together in the sanctuary, shared stories of what the Lord had done in that time, prayed together, and left filled with the Holy Spirit. It was awesome because God is awesome!

This made me think of other times in scripture we are told to “Go”:

“Go back and report to John what you hear and see: the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor.” (Matt. 11:4, 5)

“Go quickly and tell his disciples: “He has risen!” (Matt. 28:7)

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” (Matt. 28:19, 20)

As followers of Jesus Christ, we are *all* called to “Go” in some manner. Oftentimes, this will take us out of our comfort zone. Thankfully, when we go, we go in His strength – not our own. Perhaps you are not being called to knock on doors to share the Good News with strangers, but we are all called to share the Good News. And as always this must start with prayer. So where to start?
