Hello 5/6 grade parents. This week was Spirit week and our class had a lot of spirit! Almost every class member dressed up each day. I was very impressed with their enthusiasm!

In Bible this week we are continuing our study of Bible history through The Great Controversy. The students heard interesting stories which they rewrote into summaries in their journals.

English is story writing. We are going through the writing process and writing original stories. In Reading we finished our book, "Dinosaurs," and are beginning a book on Volcanoes. Students also learned to address an envelope. In doing this activity I discovered that many students do not know their addresses! Please help your child memorize their address. This is good to know in cases of emergency; they will know how to tell someone where they live.

In Math the 5th graders are studying the Commutative, Associative, and distributive properties and how to use

them to solve problems. In 6th grade our math is focused on finding the greatest/least common factor and multiple using lists and factor trees.

In Science we are learning about cells and their parts. The students used paper plates to create a plant cell and an animal cell. We also watched a video on cells.

In Social Studies we learned about the Economic rights we have as U.S. citizens, such as owning property. We are also learning about basic economics like supply and demand. When a product is more in demand generally the price goes up.

In PE the students are playing basketball. It was a little bit more pleasant this week since it was cooler! Have a great weekend! Remind students to study for Friday quizzes and read!
