This week in 5/6 grades we started a new book in Bible called, "War of the Invisibles." It is the story of the great controversy; the war between Christ and Satan but told through the eyes of angels. It goes through Bible history and helps the students feel like they are there for events like the Great Disappointment of 1844. It should be exciting reading!

In English we only did vocab and spelling due to MAP testing. In Science we are learning about different types of cells and how they are classified. Social Studies focused on the free enterprise system in America and how it works.

Math for 6th grade was factor trees and finding the least common and the greatest common factors. They also learned about numbers that are perfect squares and how to identify them. In 5th grade math they are

learning about place value. They played a game called Place value plug in using dice. It was a lot of fun!

In PE the students have completed flag football and are now playing basketball. We focus on a new sport or activity every 2 weeks.

Remind students to study for their MV, Vocab, and spelling test which take place each Friday. Students also need to read AR books to get AR points. This week students took MAP tests in Reading, Language Arts, Math, and Science. I'll send reports home when their test scores are ready to print!
