It's been so nice having everyone back at school this week! We have been working on DNA models in Science. It was fun to see the students work together with their partners to figure out how to make it.

In 5th grade Math, the students are learning how to add and subtract numbers with decimals. They have caught onto this concept pretty quickly. 6th grade is learning how to divide fractions, mixed numbers, and improper fractions. They have mostly grasped the concept of multiplying by the reciprocal when dividing fractions. Some students are still struggling with how to simplify their answers. Reviewing their multiplication facts would help them spot how they can reduce a fraction quickly.
