In Science this week, the students have been practicing using microscopes. We have been reading about mitosis and they have been using them to view the mitosis of a cell in an onion root tip.

In 5th grade Math, we have started working with multiplying whole numbers. They are learning how to multiply any number by a power of 10. 6th grade is working on multiplying decimals and division of whole numbers and decimals.

This week in 5/6 grade we read bible stories about the little maid, Elijah and the flaming chariot, and Elisha and the floating axe head. It is fun to reread

many Bible stories and remember the lessons they teach. We are also continuing to read War of the Invisibles and talk about History in relation to our church. Pastor Gil started Bible study classes this week with any students who wish to take them during Bible class. When complete, students who wish to be baptized will be referred to their church pastors for further study and/or baptism.

In English we are writing compare and contrast essays. We also write in our journals daily. In reading we finished our book on "Lewis and Clark" and will begin "First Flight", a book about hummingbirds. Remind your child to read at night their AR books so they can be ready to take AR quizzes. They need to earn 10 points each quarter.

In Social Studies we are learning about the first Americans, the native Americans. We are learning about their culture, how they lived, what they ate, and etc. There will be a Social Studies test on Monday. A study sheet was given to students on Wednesday. Please remind them to study.
