

The first paying job I ever had was apple picking at Sievers Orchard. After picking apples for hours, the Sievers would send me home with a couple of bags of apples. Afterwards, at home we'd enjoy apple-related meals, including my mother's apple sauce.

Later, after I went away to school, my mom would reminisce about the absence of those Macintosh apples. This was the memory that jumped to my mind a few days ago, as I was reading the book of Luke. Take a look at the following verses, *"And he told this parable: 'A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. And he said to the vinedresser, 'Look, for three years now I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and I find none. Cut it down. Why should it use up the ground?' And he answered him, 'Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and put on manure. Then if it should bear fruit next year, well and good; but if not, you can cut it down.'"* Luke 13:6-9

The simple truth is that there is not much use in a fruit tree that doesn't grow fruit, just like there isn't much use in a disciple of Jesus that isn't living out Jesus' teachings. God made us, the Church, to be people of growth and action. It is his desire that we constantly seek to mature in faith, and the way we do that is by to be faithful to the mission Jesus has given us. 
