SEVERE WEATHER PROTOCOL

Like other states, Wisconsin experiences a wide range of weather through its changing seasons. The week of the Camporee is historically one of the mildest times of the year for weather. Even so, it is possible to experience poor conditions.

In Case of...

1 Thunderstorms (heavy rain, high winds, hail)

Plan A - Take shelter in a building, camper, or vehicle.

Plan B - Take shelter in a sturdy tent with non-metal poles. Avoid sheltering near trees, poles, and towers.

2 Tornadoes: There are NO building shelters available. Please seek shelter in a low-lying area. Buildings NOT appropriate for shelter include the large hangars (where the honors and activities are located), shower houses, and other out buildings.

Emergency Messaging

1 **With a Cell Phone:** To receive emergency text messages sent to your phone during the camporee, visit www.camporee.org/about/safety or scan the code to the right.

2 **Without a Cell Phone:** If severe weather is approaching, listen to your battery-operated weather radio for alerts. We will also notify all conference youth directors by two-way radio on **channel 8**.

BUS & SHUTTLE SCHEDULES

Getting Around at the Camporee

The Chosen International Pathfinder Camporee requires the movement of thousands of people throughout the day. We provide on-site and off-site shuttles to get you where you need to be in a timely manner. See the Camporee map to find a Bus/Shuttle location.



Special Needs: Many of the buses are wheelchair accessible for persons with special needs.



Off-site Activities Bus Schedule: These buses take you to the off-site activities and leave every 30 minutes. Buses load at the Off-site Daytime Activities Bus Loading Zone.

Compassion/Community Service Ministry Bus Schedule: These buses take you to the Compassion Ministry projects. Buses leave from the Compassion Ministry Bus Stop.

NOTE: These buses are different than the other Off-site activity buses.

Daily at 9:00 AM for morning projects and 1:00 PM for afternoon projects.



Off-site Shopping Bus Schedule: These buses take you to Walmart, Target, Festival Foods, and the Outlet Shoppes at Oshkosh. Buses leave from the Bus Park.

On-site Shuttle Bus Schedule: These buses take you to 4 different bus stops throughout the Camporee grounds. Buses leave/drop off, every 15 - 20 minutes from the North, South, East & West Bus Stops.

RV Pumping & Filling: Sewer & greywater pumping: \$40.00 per pumping. Fresh water fills: \$45.00 per fill (cash only). Open Tuesday–Friday, 7:00 AM–1:00 PM, and available for emergencies on Sabbath. Stop at the EAA Campground RV Dump Station at the south gate on Sunday before leaving to empty your RV at no cost. Located at Schaick and 31st.



Golf Cart Fuel: Available Tuesday - Friday, 9:00–11:00 AM & 3:00–5:00 PM, free of charge. Located at Schaick Ave. & Doolittle Rd.



Propane Filling: Refill hours are Monday - Friday, 9:00–11:00 AM & 3:00–5:00 PM. Not open on Sabbath. Prices: \$25.00 for #20 cylinders, \$35.00 for #30 cylinders, and \$90 for #100 cylinders (cash only). Located near the West Gate.



Generators: Quiet generators may be used 6:00 AM–11:00 PM. Be sure that generators do not exhaust into any camper's tent area.



Shower Houses: To avoid long lines at the shower houses, stagger the times which you send your Pathfinders to shower. During the day, shower houses typically have no lines!



Greywater: Your dish waste water (greywater) should be poured into the tanks located near your campground. Do not pour it on the ground or leave food scraps in the water as this will clog the hoses of the trucks that pump the tanks. Strain out any food and dispose of it in the garbage.



Wi Fi Hot Spots: Located throughout the Camporee grounds and inside hangars A, B, C, & D. Wi Fi turns off at 11:00 PM.



Charging Stations: You may charge your electronic devices at any of the WiFi stations located throughout the Camporee grounds, at your own risk.



Exit on Saturday Night: Only Clubs leaving Saturday night after the evening program may bring their buses and vans into their campsites at 7:30 PM, through the South Gate only. The South Gate will close again at 9:00 PM. At 11:00 PM, all gates will be open to anyone wanting to exit the Camporee grounds.

MEDICAL AND HEALTH TIPS

The medical headquarters is staffed with medical professionals 24/7 as well as paramedics throughout the Camporee grounds to assist with medical needs. An ambulance will also be on-site many hours of the day.

Medical Tips

- 1 Emergency Response:** Please let the medical teams determine when an ambulance is needed. **Call (269) 921-2161 or Radio Channel 16.**
- 2 Locality:** Develop a system within your club and surrounding clubs to direct the medical team to your location in an emergency. Be aware of your surroundings—note nearby street signs and landmarks.
- 3 Medical History:** Please make sure that all your Pathfinders have a medical history and release form carried with them wherever they go. Keep a copy secured in a Director's car or RV.
- 4 Medications:** Please assist your campers by making sure they take all medication as prescribed.

Health Tips

- 1 Best Practices**
 - Stay hydrated. Keep a water bottle close at all times.
 - Wash hands often throughout the day.
 - Bring hand sanitizer to use before meals and after portable toilet use.
 - Sneeze or cough into the shoulder or elbow.
 - Determine ways to protect yourself from excessive sun exposure.
- 2 Toilets (Port-O-Lets)**
 - Portable toilets will be emptied and cleaned twice daily. Bring a small roll of toilet paper with you when using a toilet.
- 3 Showers**
 - Pathfinders must be accompanied by a supervising adult to enter a Shower House.
 - Keep showers to 5 minutes so everyone else will get a chance to shower and stagger your shower times.

NIGHTTIME PROGRAM

- 1 Main Stage Access / Saving Seats:** The Main Stage seating arena will be open all day. You will only be able to save 1 seat for 1 other person. 1 person cannot save a large seating space for an entire club. You will be asked to remove your blankets or chairs if only one person is present. Please do not leave chairs or blankets overnight in order to save your spot. All items left after each program will be placed in Lost & Found.
- 2 Hearing Impaired:** Sign language is provided in the northeast corner near the stage.
- 3 Baptism:** Baptisms take place Wednesday - Friday, 6:00–6:45 PM and Sabbath, 8:00–8:45 AM. Baptismal candidates and pastors should arrive 30 minutes prior.

- 4 “Bible & Buck”:** Bring an English or Spanish Bible to be collected before any nighttime program (Tuesday–Friday) after 6:00 PM. Along with your Bible, bring US\$1.00. This money will help with Bible distribution around the world. Bibles may be dropped off at the southeast entrances to the Main stage Arena.
- 5 Camporee Choir:** Rehearsals take place Wednesday–Friday, 2:00–3:00 PM, Sabbath: 8:45 AM on the Main Stage. If you would like to participate in the choir, we will be taking the first 300 Pathfinders who line up by the ‘Choir’ sign at the front right side of the Main Stage, by the baptismal tanks at 2:00 PM, Wednesday August 14, 2019.
- 6 Sabbath Offering:** The Sabbath morning offering will help support Bible distribution and maintenance of the Pathfinder mission plane to Uganda. Our goal is \$100,000 (about US\$2.00 per person). The pathfinders in Cuba will also be receiving a portion of Sabbath’s offerings.
- 7 Pathfinder Dress:** Pathfinder Class A / Full Dress uniform is required for the Sabbath morning worship and Investiture service.
- 8 Investiture Service for MG:** Investiture applications will be accepted through August 9, 2019. Only Master Guides will be invested at the Camporee. All investiture applications received prior to June 16, 2019 will receive the commemorative pin and certificate at no cost. All applications received from June 16 through July 23, 2019 will need to pay \$10.00 for their certificate & pin at the AdventSource booth in Hangar A. All investiture applications received after July 23, 2019 will still be eligible for Investiture while at the Camporee, however, we will only provide a pin and certificate if you request them at the AdventSource booth in Hangar A. The cost will be \$12.00. A certificate and commemorative pin will still be available to you, however, they will be mailed to you after the Camporee is over.
- 9 Meet & Greet the Cast:** Visit with the David Story actors. Meet David and others at the Talent Stage, Wednesday–Friday, 2:00–3:00 PM.
