Jesus responded, “Why are you afraid? You have so little faith!” Then He got up and rebuked the wind and waves, and suddenly there was a great calm. Matthew 8:26 (NLT)

Exhausted from a hectic day of teaching and healing, Jesus sought refuge in the boat. At His request, the disciples pushed off into the lake. The weary Master retreated for a nap. Before long, boisterous waves lapped against the watercraft. Howling winds threatened to capsize the vessel. The disciples wrestled against the angry storm. Frantically, they shouted at Jesus, “We’re gonna drown! Don’t You even care?” Jesus awoke, rebuked the storm, and then all was calm.
