





HOW TO MAKE A MOVING PAPER FISH

MATERIALS

-  2 sheets of 8.5"×11" paper in different colors
-  Scissors
-  Glue dots
-  Marker

DIRECTIONS

1. Cut one sheet of 8.5"×11" paper into a 8.5"×8.5" square (this will be the body of the fish)
2. Create a diagonal center fold in the sheet
3. Fold both sides in as if creating a paper airplane
4. Fold the paper diagonally along the fold created in step 2
5. Cut strips along the inside fold until you are $\frac{3}{4}$ down the sheet
6. Apply glue on the inside left flap
7. Glue the inside of the left flap to the outside of the right flap, creating a 3D triangular tube. This will be the fish body.
8. Using the second sheet of paper, cut out 2 leaf-shaped fins, 2 circles for the eyes, 1 heart-shaped fish tail, and a half circle for the tongue.
9. With your marker, draw details on the eyes, fins, and tail
10. Apply glue to each piece and attach it to the body of the fish
