QUESTIONS / IN CASE OF RAIN

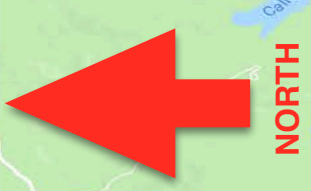
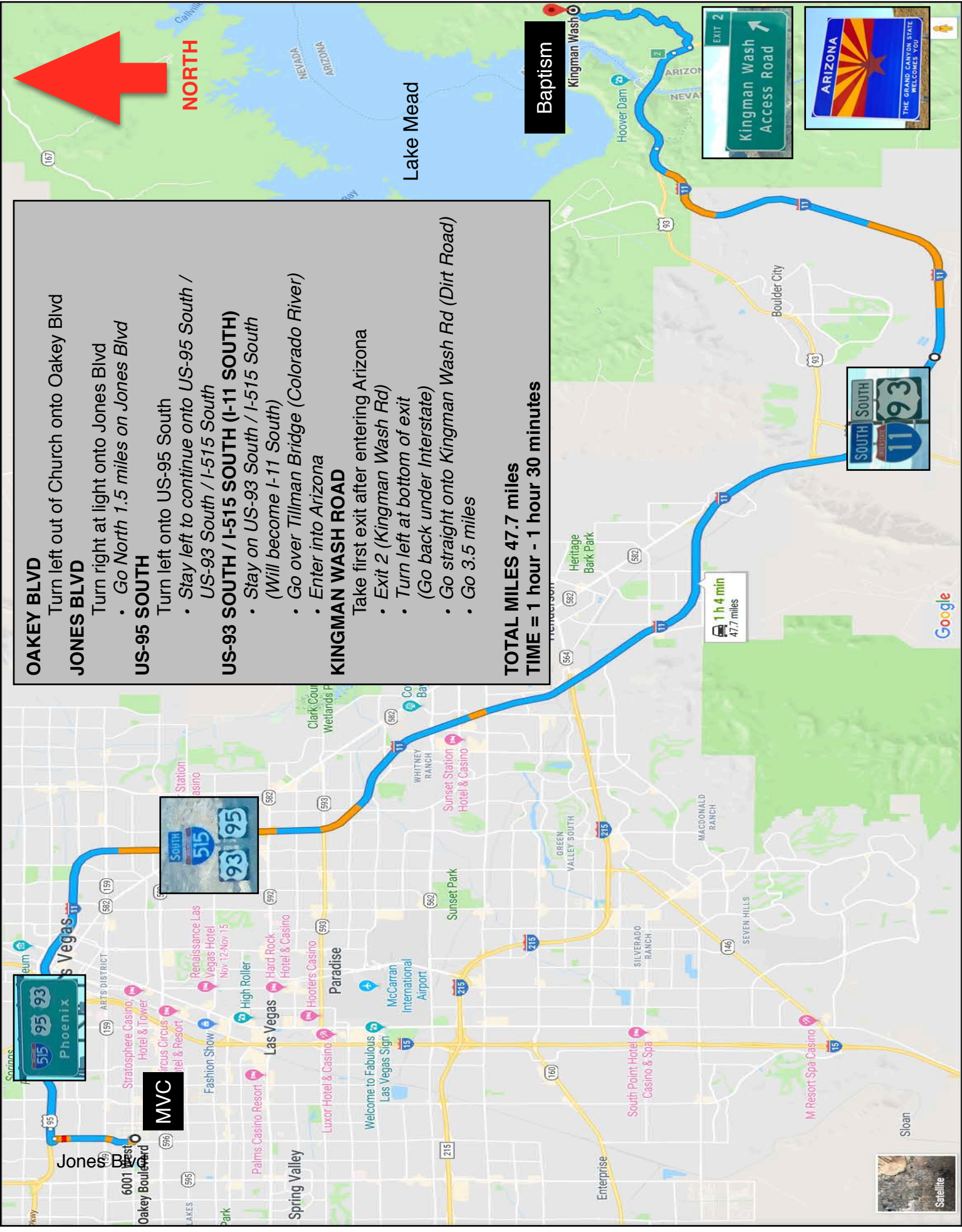
- We have never been rained out so this is unlikely as the Lord has always provided.

NOTE TO ATTENDEES

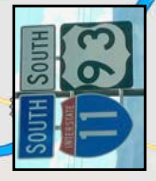
- Carpooling is suggested

Turn left out of Church onto Oakley Blvd

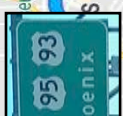
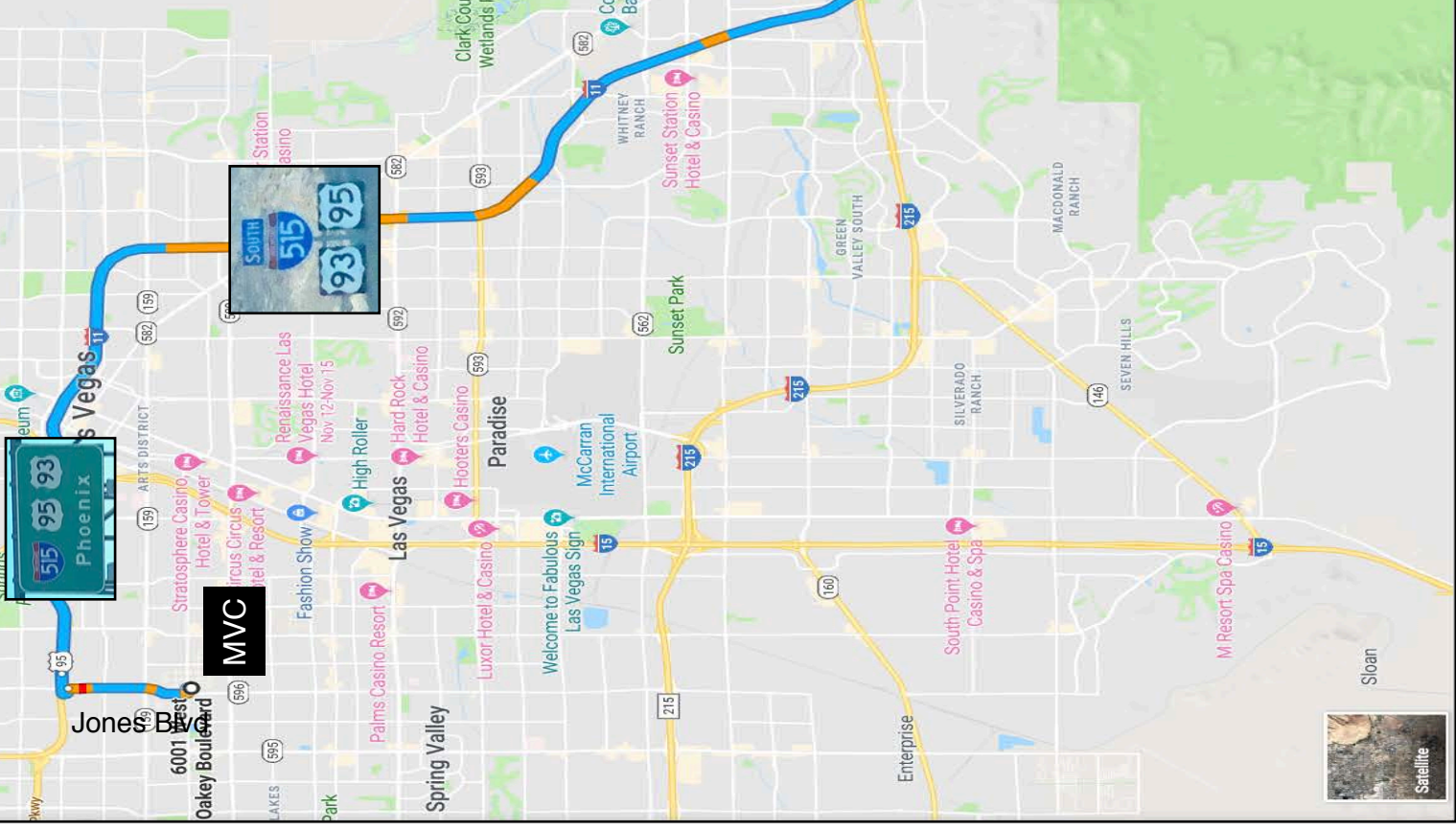
JONES BLVD
Turn right at light onto Jones Blvd
• Go North 1.5 miles on Jones Blvd

US-95 SOUTH
Turn left onto US-95 South
• Stay left to continue onto US-95 South / US-93 South / I-515 South

US-93 SOUTH / I-515 SOUTH (I-11 SOUTH)
• Stay on US-93 South / I-515 South (Will become I-11 South)
• Go over Tillman Bridge (Colorado River)
• Enter into Arizona

KINGMAN WASH ROAD
Take first exit after entering Arizona
• Exit 2 (Kingman Wash Rd)
• Turn left at bottom of exit (Go back under Interstate)
• Go straight onto Kingman Wash Rd (Dirt Road)
• Go 3.5 miles

TOTAL MILES 47.7 miles
TIME = 1 hour - 1 hour 30 minutes
