RELIGIOUS LIBERTY

Wow, it is already the last Sabbath of the first month of 2019. We just finished our church plan for the whole year of 2019. I am excited to begin implement our church action plans.

Today is the Liberty Sabbath. It is about the religious freedom. What is religious freedom? The Seventh-day Adventist Church strongly believes in Religious Freedom for all people. A person's conscience, not government, should dictate his or her choice to worship or not. The Church has advocated for these goals for more than 100 years, through the department of Public Affairs and Religious Liberty (PARL).

What do we advocate? There are many forms such as fighting against laws that would inhibit an individual's religious freedoms, working to obtain the release of individual imprisoned for religious reasons and supporting the rights of individuals fired from their jobs for following their conscience.

The Adventist Church believes that fighting religious oppression and defending an individual's right to worship according to his or her conscience—regardless of that person's religious affiliation—is in everyone's best interest.

What is the Liberty Sabbath? It is about the freedom to worship God. Once a year our Adventist Church invites every member to participate in sponsoring religious liberty by subscribing Liberty Magazines in order to send it to any public servant, government officer, provincial, municipal officer, MP, MPP, public library, or lawyer. This is an opportunity that every Adventist can participate in promoting religious liberty in a big way.

What is freedom? How can we have a real freedom? Most people generally consider freedom from the perspective of the benefits that one can receive from it. Actually, we think about it in terms of fundamental human rights, such as freedom of religion, or freedom of expression; a social and legal value to be defended and preserved. However, when we consider it from a biblical perspective, we find that there is far more to the concept of freedom than first meets the eye.

Jesus promised his disciples and us to make all free (John 8:36) and He also added, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:31).

I would like to invite you to join me during the sermon time and learn more how we can have God's real freedom.
