# PASTOR'S CORNER

February 1, 2020

## Announcement for Mount Zion members

Happy Sabbath everyone! With the spreading of the coronavirus problem, I would like to encourage everyone take precaution when we greet each other. As for precaution, we will temporarily stop to have shaking hands and hug during at the welcome time and the end of our church worship service.

Let's continue to practice Coronavirus prevention recommended by the CBC News. [1] Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer. [2] Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. [3] Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. [4] Avoid close contact with people who are sick. [5] Clean and disinfect frequently touched object and surfaces. [6] Stay home when you are sick. Let's continue to pray for those who are infected and sick at this moment.

## What is Discipleship?

As we have been learning about the discipleship which consists of the five stages of spiritual maturity since the first week of 2020. Today we will learn the third stage of this process during the sermon time.

Let me reflect with you what example Jesus has left for us. While Jesus was here on earth, he gave us a model of leadership to follow. He lived among His disciples for three years as they watched and helped him minister to those in the communities they traveled through. He used his relationship with them to show them what to do, then he engaged their help, and eventually he sent them out to ministry, and he debriefed with them when they were done. This is what I call discipleship. It is a reproducible process of relational discipleship.

This model I call the reproducible process of relational discipleship. The process that Jesus modeled for us is timeless. It transcends geographical and cultural barriers. This process does not need a theological degree or complete knowledge of every spiritual issue. Every one of us who follow Christ is able to disciple another, no matter where we are in the process, or any level of maturity we are. In order to lead others, we must be disciplined toward a specific destination. We do not need to have been there ourselves or at least have a map.

Our destination is spiritual maturity. Spiritual maturity is about to become like Jesus. We may not be able to achieve on this earth, but it is the goal we should be striving for. He is our ultimate example of what maturity looks like. When we are spiritually mature means we seek to understand the heart of God and seek to love what and whom He loves. At the end result of discipleship is a disciple who is making other disciples.

All Christ's followers must learn to become disciple-makers or intentional disciple-makers. As intentional disciple-makers, we need to evaluate where our disciples are on their spiritual journey so that we can determine what they need from us. In order to do this well, we must be in relationship with them. Our role as disciple-makers is to help the disciple mature and grow so he can move from stage of development to the next, so that he can eventually disciple others. As we spend time together and close proximately we are able to know the maturity level of the person we are discipling and where he needs to grow.

How is your spiritual journey? What spiritual stage are you in? what is your "NEXT STEP"?
