Exciting things are happening in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Pastors Sam and Neil along with the All Nations Seventh-day Adventist Church are working together with two influential Indigenous leaders, Lloyd and Lawrence, to advance Native Ministry.

The church sponsored Lloyd and Lawrence to attend the First Nations Adventist Wellness Coach Training. They learned how to reach out to Indigenous people with a balanced message of physical, spiritual, mental and social health. Lloyd and Lawrence returned to Winnipeg all fired up to reach their own people. They began leading out in several home Bible study groups. They met with Bernadette Smith, a member of the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba, to plan health expos and diabetes prevention programs. They volunteered at the Adventist Community Services to meet people and influence them to renew their relationship with their Creator. They have formulated plans for a depression recovery seminar and have assisted individuals to prevent suicides.

The best news of all was when both Lloyd and Lawrence felt confident in the Adventist message of hope and wholeness and that this church was committed to reaching Indigenous people for Jesus, so they were baptized and joined the All Nations Seventh-day Adventist Church.
