

# Suggested Items to Bring for Ouachita Hills Academy

## Spiritual Growth and Personal Bible Study:

- **Bible:** All must have at least one. Other options include:
  - ♦ **Small Pocket Bible:** Having a small one that can be used in class without taking up much space is handy.
  - ♦ **Larger Literal Translation:** It is beneficial to have a larger literal translation for personal Bible study. Seniors will need a high quality Bible that they will want to keep for life. This will be marked with Bible Studies during their Bible Doctrines class. A literal translation such as the KJV or NKJV is preferable for personal study although other translations can also be helpful. All should have a quality personal Bible that they will value, and keep for life. They will want to be able to personally highlight and notate for their life.
  - ♦ **Bible Marking Pens/Pencils:** Are useful for personal Bible study and highlighting your Bible.
  - ♦ **Journal:** A notebook for journaling personal devotions is useful.
- **Spirit of Prophecy Books:**
  - \* **Hardback *Desire of Ages*, by Ellen G. White:** Each 1<sup>st</sup> years student who has not taken a Gospels or *Life and Teachings of Jesus* class will need a 5 3/4" by 8" hardback copy of the *Desire of Ages* that goes with the *Conflict of the Ages* series set.   - ♦ **Daily Devotional Material:** Material for personal devotions. Some beneficial suggestions include: *Daily Devotionals, Patriarchs and Prophets, Messages to Young People, Christ Object Lessons, Thoughts From the Mount of Blessings, Story of Redemption, Education*, etc.
  - ♦ **Conflict of the Ages Series (Optional):** Although the full set is not required, it is highly recommended since many of the 5 volumes will be referenced in various classes.
- **Bible Study Resources (Not required but useful tools for Bible study)**
  - ♦ **Thompson Chain Reference Bible:** This Bible has many cross-reference studies on various topics.
  - ♦ **Strong's Concordance:** Can be helpful for deep Bible study.
  - ♦ **Vine's Complete Expository Dictionary** of Old and New Testament Words
  - ♦ **Treasury of Scripture Knowledge:** A wonderful resource for deep Bible Study.

## Suggested School Supplies:

- **Paper and Pen Related Supplies**
  - \* Zippered 3 Ring Binder (A zippered one is needed for *Life and Teachings of Jesus*. 2" works well.)
  - \* 8 Tab Dividers (For the 3 ring binder. It should be a set of 8 not 2 sets of 5 dividers for LTJ)
  - \* Plain, College Ruled, 3-hole-punched Notebook Paper (Some teachers may not permit colored paper)
  - \* Pencils (Mechanical pencils work great) (Needed for LTJ)
  - \* Yellow Highlighter (Needed for LTJ)
  - \* Red Pen (Needed for LTJ)
  - ♦ Erasers
  - ♦ Graph Paper
  - ♦ Spiral Bound Notebooks for taking notes
  - ♦ Protractor & Compass (For Geometry class and illustrative art work)
  - ♦ Ruler
  - ♦ Scissors
  - ♦ Stapler
  - ♦ Scotch Tape (Not for mounting pictures on walls –tacky putty must be used for mounting on walls)
  - ♦ Glue Sticks
  - ♦ 3 x 5 index cards (for making memory card)
  - ♦ Colored Pencils or Pens / Crayons (useful for art/illustration assignments)
- **Other School Supplies**
  - ♦ Scientific Calculator (May not be used for Pre-algebra or Algebra 1 but needed for other math classes)
  - ♦ School Backpack/Book Bag: For carrying books to class (we do not have school lockers)

## Required Personal Items:

- Wrist Watch (Required & essential for following the schedule and avoiding tardies)
- Umbrella or Rain Coat
- Sleeping Bag (Required for all for camp outs, backpacking, choir trips, etc.)
- Sleeping Pad (Required for sleeping on the floor camp outs, backpacking, choir trips, etc.)
- Flashlight or Headlamp (for camping)
- Quart Sized Water Bottle (for trips)

## **Dormitory Room Items:**

- Desk Lamp (Crucial for studying)
- Pillow and Pillowcase
- Twin Sized Bed Linen
  - ◆ Twin Flat Sheet & Fitted sheets
  - ◆ Twin sized blanket
  - ◆ Twin sized bedspread
- Toiletries (Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Shampoo, Soap, Deodorant, Hair comb/brush, Hair styling, etc.)
- Towels and Washcloths
- Laundry Sack or Laundry Basket
- Water Filter (Like a pitcher type desk counter top water filter like a Brita or Pur water available from Wal-Mart)
- Pictures of Family
- Decorations (Posters must be approved)
  - ◆ Tacky Putty (For mounting posters on wall walls – scotch tape cannot be used for this)

## **Clothes & Shoes:** (see Guidelines in Handbook)

- **School Clothes:**
  - ◆ Boys: Nice Jeans or slacks & collard shirts
  - ◆ Girls: Skirts or dresses
- **Vocational Training Clothes:**
  - ◆ Boys: Work jeans or slacks without holes.
  - ◆ Work boots may be beneficial for the men if they have them but any sturdy shoes are generally fine.
  - ◆ Work Gloves
  - ◆ Safety Glasses
  - ◆ Hearing Protection
- **Sabbath Clothes**—please bring clothes that are solely for Sabbath hours since this is a special time with the Lord
  - ◆ Boys: Dress Slacks, Dress Shirts, Dress Shoes and Tie (A suit is nice but not required unless in Small Choir)
- **Choir Uniform**
  - ◆ Boys: Black Dress Pants, Black Shoes, Black Belt, and White Dress Shirt (Tie will be provided)
  - ◆ Girls: Black Shoes, Black Skirt and White Blouse
- **Chorale Uniform** for boys selected in the small choir is a Black Suit. (All others uniforms will be rented)
- **Swim Attire:**
  - ◆ Modest Swimsuit (for segregated swimming)
  - ◆ Swim Clothes (Modest, dark colored, water-type clothes for activities such as the canoe trip)
- **Modest Sleep Attire** (Particularly for school trips)
- **Shoes:**
  - ◆ Socks
  - ◆ Athletic Shoes for Physical Education
  - ◆ Dress Shoes for Sabbath
  - ◆ Sturdy, closed-toed shoes for work in vocational areas including kitchen. No open-toed shoes are allowed.
  - ◆ School: Sandals may be worn in warmer months but closed-toed should be worn during colder months.

## **Musical Instruments:**

- Musical Instruments such as Violins, Brass, Flute, Guitar, Ukulele, Recorder, etc. (No drums or electric guitars)
- Music books (within the guidelines for acceptable music)
- Electronic instruments must be pre-approved

## **Miscellaneous Items:**

- Stationery, envelopes and stamps
- Thank You Cards / Birthday Cards, etc.
- Backpacking Equipment for Optional Spring Backpacking Trip
  - ◆ Backpacking Backpack (May be rented if the student doesn't have them)
  - ◆ Optional: Backpacking Tent, Backpacking Stove
- Bicycle with helmet
- Skateboard with helmet, kneepads, elbow pads, and wrist guards.

\* Item Required for Life and Teachings of Jesus Class

- Underlined items are required (others are suggested & helpful but optional)
