GUIDELINES for RE-OPENING of Churches in BC Conference:

A group no greater than 50 people may congregate in one place. Practice 6-foot physical distancing (including Praise team), including entering and exiting the church, going to and from the platform, etc. Wash your hands regularly and avoid touching your face. This is the most important COVID-19 preventions.

Wash hands with plain soap and water OR an alcohol-based hand sanitizer (with a minimum of 60% alcohol content), before and after services, meetings, or events. Encourage members to greet each other with a smile and wave, as opposed to any direct person-to-person contact.

Cover your mouth and nose with your elbow when coughing or sneezing and avoid others who are unwell. Cough into your elbow or use a tissue to avoid coughing or sneezing into either your hands or into the air. Dispose of used tissues right away and immediately wash your hands. Hand shaking or hugs are not permitted

Families can sit together. Fellowship meals, buffets, potlucks, or sharing of food or utensils are not permitted. Eating pre-packaged meals is permitted.
