campaigning for offices in the new 2021-2022**

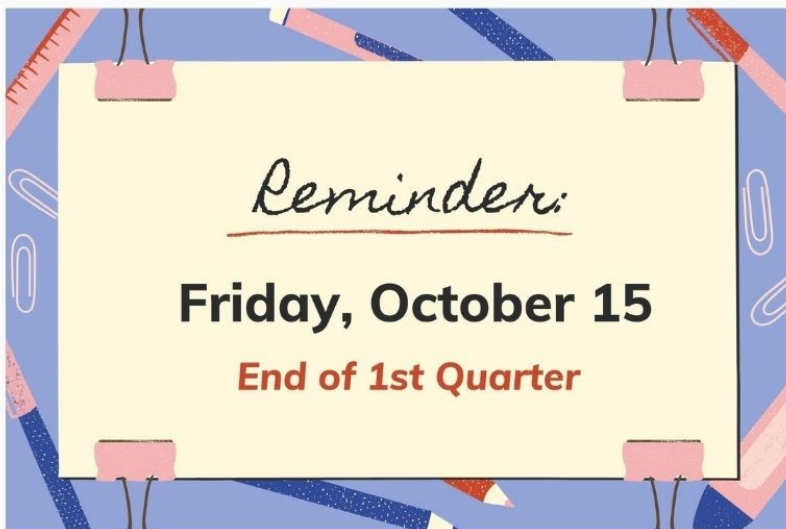
Saipan SDA School Student Council election process.

Speeches were presented in Friday Chapel on October 1 campaigning for president, vice-president, treasurer, assistant treasurer, secretary, assistant secretary, chaplain, parliamentarian, and the position of school ambassador. One inspirational speech, campaigning for chaplain, stated, "I know I have no complete knowledge of all that's in the Holy Bible, but I'm willing to learn and share what God gives me to share". In fact, one speech campaigner gave a clear speech with a short story of their past connection serving on the 2020-2021 council.

The voting process took place this past Thursday afternoon (October 7), and the results were somewhat surprising to many students. The new uncontested and undisputed student council president for the 2021-2022 term is Kyle Diesta who is one of the eighth graders with 100% of the votes counted (meaning every voter voted for her). Her assistant, Kelly Selkor (seventh grader) had a few tough contestants, yet she pulled it out with 40% of the total votes counted. Jessica Ahn, a sixth grader, ran close behind her with 27% of the total votes counted. Dennis Ahn, another uncontested eighth grader received 90% of the total votes counted to become the school's ambassador. The position of secretary was won by Elin Kim,



sixth grader, and her assistant was uncontested by Kelly Ahn, a sixth grader. Treasurer position was won by Jenna Qiu, eighth grader. Her assistant was won by Ian Ahn, another sixth grader. Chaplain was won by Orica George, fifth grader, while parliamentarian was won by Sarah Jin, seventh grader.
