

COVID-19 Guidelines

Dear School Family,

The school has the following guidelines for 2021-2022. It is as follows:

~school will be cleaned and sanitized professionally prior to school opening.

~hand sanitizers and cleansing wipes will be available in each classroom and throughout the school.

~masks or face shields are not mandatory (**yet**) in the state of New Hampshire. However, if you want your child to wear a mask, that's fine.
Temperature will be taken daily.

~desks will be 2-3 feet apart to practice social distancing.

~procedures for bathroom use, playground use, and drinking fountain will be posted.

~cleaning and sanitizing will be done daily on desks, door knobs, handles, etc.,

~if student becomes sick during the day, an isolation room has been set up.

~if your child/children have the following symptoms please keep them home.

Fever or chills (100.4 or higher)

Coughing-not related to allergies or asthma

Sore throat

Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Fatigue or tired

Nausea or vomiting

Diarrhea

Congestion or runny nose not related to allergies

Muscle or body aches
