## Ski Club

## Late Pick Up Policy

**After school board review, our late pick up policy has been updated.** We understand occasions arise when parents may be running late to pick up their children and we want to be gracious, however those minutes add up over time. Teachers are occupied with end of the day tasks and there are no other staff members in the building to supervise children waiting on parent pickup. **Therefore, parents who have not picked up their student(s) by 3:20pm Monday-Thursday or 12:05pm on Friday will accrue late pick up fees at the rate of \$1/minute.** Monday-Thursday students will wait in the after-school care program. On Friday, students will wait with a designated teacher.

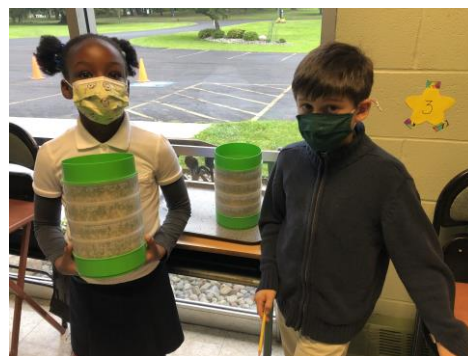


## Alfalfa Sprouts Sales

## After School Care Fast Facts

- Program hours: **M-Th 3:15-5:30pm**
- Fee: **\$4/child per hour and \$1/quarter hour (any minutes after the quarter hour count as a quarter hour)**
- All fees **paid in advance, CASH only**
- Initial deposit of **\$36/child**, bank up each Friday
- Unused funds will roll over

If you are interested in signing your child up for after-school care, please contact the office.

## Absent or Sick Child/**Early Pick-Up**

If your child will be absent for the day, please call the office (leave a message if necessary) or **TEXT** the teacher **before 9am** to inform them of the reason for the absence.

**Early pick-up is available IF your child has a medical appointment or emergency. Please call the office or text the teacher no later than the morning of to notify of medical appointments and at least an hour in advance (if able) in the case of an emergency. Thanks!**

## COVID Resources

**A NEW Testing site for asymptomatic return-to-school testing is located at the Boys & Girls club at 201 Hamilton St. from 9am-12pm M-F. Same day results are available so that students with a negative result may return to school the following day. An appointment is required.**
