# **Bonfire Worship**

#### After School Care

Our after school care program will begin this Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>. Prisca, a graduate of Parkview will be in charge of the program under the guidance of our teaching staff. The program hours are M-Th 3:15-5:30pm. The fee is \$4/child per hour and \$1/quarter hour. This fee is most reasonable as market rates for after care services are up to 4 times this so please do not quibble over minutes. In order to use the service all fees need to be paid in advance. If you did not pay the initial \$36/child deposit by today, please bring payment in full on Monday morning. Any unused funds will roll over. Each Friday you must bank up to \$36/child to allow him/her to participate in after care services the following week. All payments must be in the form of cash or check. Children will be signed out at time of pick up, please be prompt.
