

Elder Don C. Schneider, former president of the North American Division of Seventh-day Adventists (NAD), passed away on May 23, 2019, in Burleson, Texas. Elder Schneider served as the NAD president from 2000 to 2010. He was well known in the Pacific Union, and he served as the president of the Northern California Conference from 1989 to 1994.

Pastor Ricardo Graham, president of the Pacific Union Conference, issued this short remembrance of Elder Schneider: "There is no doubt that Elder Don

Schneider was a person who loved the Lord, his family, and the Seventh-day Adventist Church. I served as a pastor under his leadership when he was president of the Northern California Conference. Charismatic as a person, he led with a passion for youth. He had a pastor's heart and a great sense of humor. Elder Schneider was a fun-loving person who could relate a humorous anecdote and get a crowd or congregation laughing out loud, but he was serious about reaching souls for Jesus. Don and Marti were a power couple for the Lord. He will be missed. On behalf of the entire Pacific Union Conference, we wish his family and friends our deeply felt condolences, and we look forward to a reunion when Jesus comes."
