Application for Admission

All students (new or returning) must complete an online “Application for Admission” form which will be reviewed for approval by the PHAS Admissions Committee.

DETAILS: Bring the following personal identification for your child(ren):

- **Alberta Health Care number** (new students only)
- **birth certificate** (new students only)
- **proof of citizenship** (of student and parents, if not Canadian)

NOTE: All Registrants must submit completed application forms and be approved by the PHAS Admissions Committee before the first day of school. Registration forms can take up to 2 weeks to process.

School Entrance Age

Students entering **ECS (Kindergarten)** must attain the age of 5 years old and not more than 7 years old by September 30. Students entering **Grade 1** must attain the age of 6 years old by September 30.

Financial Information and Policies:

Registration Fees:

Registration fees cover the agenda, and classroom expenses. Fee payment arrangements need to be made in September by completing the financial information forms and submitting it to PHAS.

- Kindergarten to Grade Nine Registration: \$250
- Kindergarten to Grade Nine Technology Fee: \$100

Tuition Fee:
