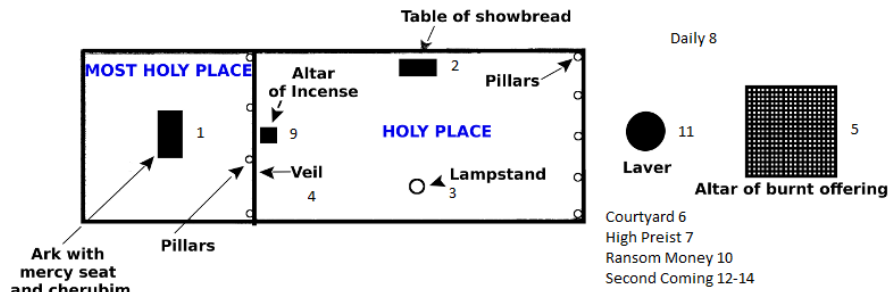


Plan of Salvation

(1) Jesus was the ark of Gods law in heaven and had the law within his heart. He had mercy on those who sinned against God and he kept the world from being destroyed giving mankind another chance. (2) He did mighty works in this world as food and drink to supply our spiritual needs. (3) He gave the light of his plan of salvation to the world. He told us what we need to know to be saved. He did this all through the Old Testament. (4) He then veiled his divine glory in a human body so he could live among us. (5) He was presented before the alter at his birth. (6) Lived a sinless life to be a perfect sacrifice on the alter and to be our righteousness. He came to the church of the time, which was Israel. He had the oil of the Holy Spirit throughout his life. (7) He put upon his heart and shoulders the burdens of the world. He then started his ministry for the world by being washed in baptism, putting on the garments of the burdens of sin, and was anointed with the Holy Spirit fully. He died to be the sacrifice to pay for our sins and be consecrated so he could be the perfect High Priest. (8) He then became the daily interceding priest to plead his blood in our behalf and forgive those sins which are brought to him. (9) He covered the sins brought to the sanctuary beforehand with the fragrance of his prayers up to and through the Judgment. (10) We are required to give only the small pittance of this sinful life in exchange for eternal life and happiness and the judgment is to determine whether we did. (11) As we confess and repent of our sins, the Holy Spirit works in our lives to clean us up. Between the start of the judgment and Jesus' second coming, the Holy Spirit is also poured out in a special way to give the Gospel message one last time and prepare a people for his coming. There will be a group of people who would rather die than sin against God. Everyone will make their final decision for or against God. (12) At this time, the judgment is finished and probation closes, he is crowned and God the Father gives Jesus his kingdom. (13) Those who are saved will be protected through the plagues as well as protected from his glory by the fragrant incense of his prayer, "Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory" John 17:24. (14) Jesus is finally with us in person, we will abide forever as we keep the Sabbath each week to honor him as creator of the universe.
