COVID-19 VACCINATIONS FROM LLUMC

Loma Linda University Health is working with San Bernardino County in following a phased approach to provide the Covid-19 vaccine to our community. Based on current [county tier guidelines](#), you are eligible to receive a vaccine if you are a San Bernardino County resident in tier 1, 2 or 3 of Phase 1A or are 65 years of age or older.

By scheduling an appointment, you certify that you are either a San Bernardino County resident 65 years of age or older or that you reside or work in San Bernardino County and meet Phase 1A (tiers 1, 2, or 3) criteria.

Upon arrival to your appointment, you will be required to show proof of residence or employment within San Bernardino County. We will not be able to administer a vaccine without this documentation.
