We recognize that there are still vulnerable people among us. Please consider the following guidelines from California Department of Public Health referred to by the Conference:

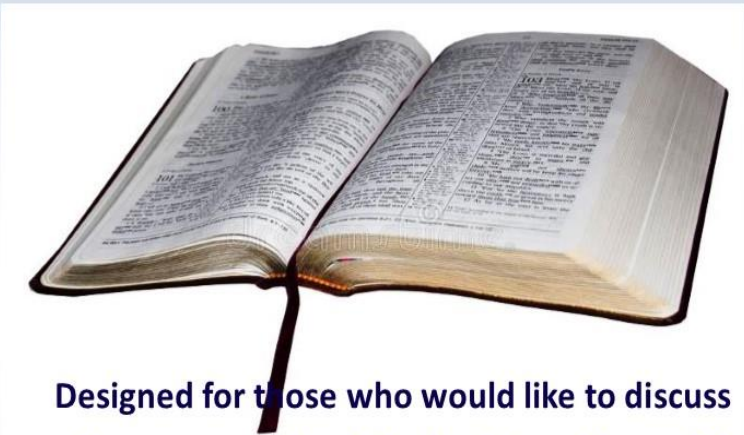
- ◆ **At this time most restrictions have been lifted.**

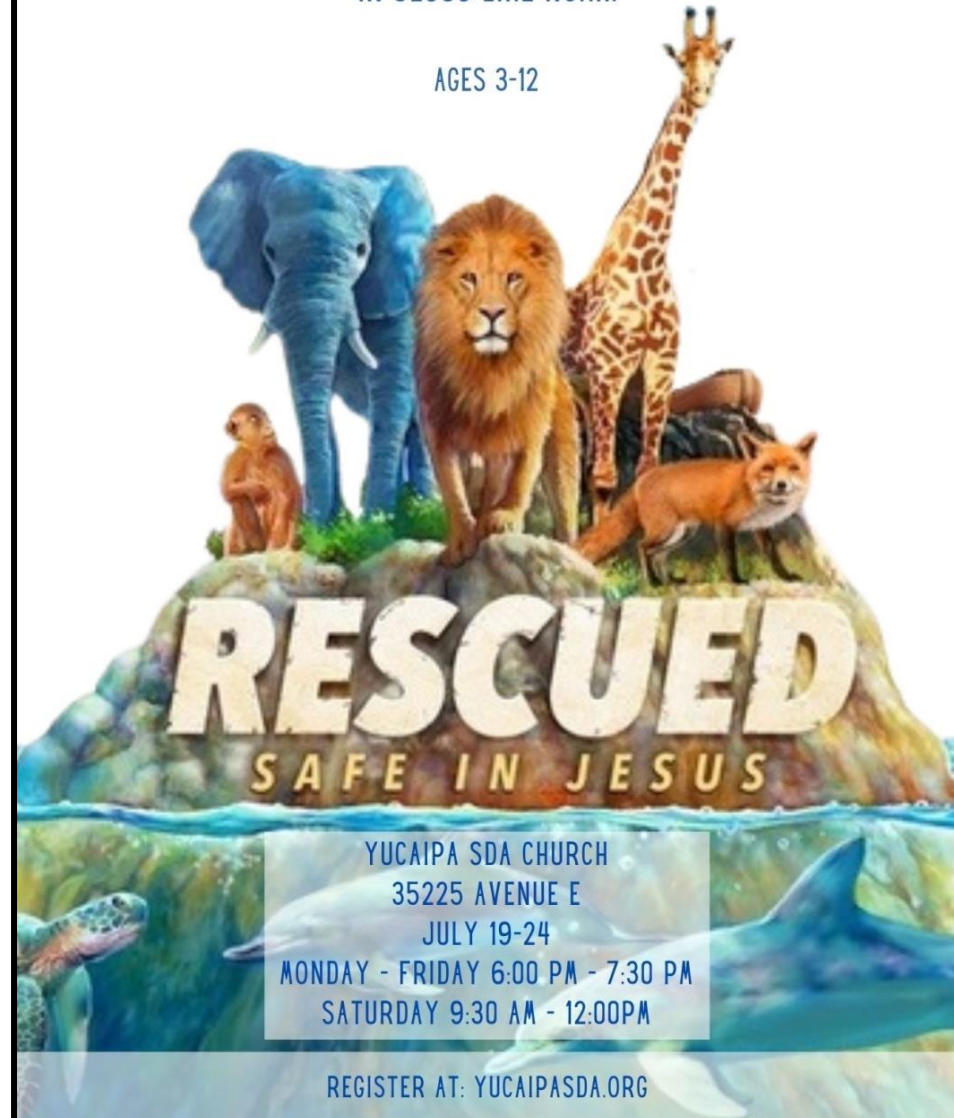
